Board of Directors Scholarship

Mountain View Medical Center was organized in 1977 by people of the North Wilkes School Area with a grant from The State of North Carolina Office Rural Health. On November 1, 1978 the doors were opened for the first patients to be seen at the Center. Our goal was then, and is still the same to provide the best medical care possible for the people of our community and surrounding area.

The Mountain View Medical Center Scholarship has been established to reward a North Wilkes High Student, male or female senior, for a job well done and encourage them to move toward a lifetime of learning through the completion of a college degree in a Medical Field. We feel that the medical field is an area that a student that has compassion to serve their fellow mankind, can and will be greatly rewarded. Finishing high school is only the beginning of life's journey. It is the hope of the Mountain View Medical Center Board of Directors that this Scholarship will help encourage the selected student into fulfilling their own dream of obtaining a college education in some field of the medical profession.

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A one year scholarship of \$1,500.00

1. This scholarship will be awarded annually to two outstanding male or outstanding female senior graduating from North Wilkes High School.
 2. Qualifying characteristics will include financial need and a strong motivation to finish college. Applicants should have a weighted GPA of at least 3.0 at the end of the first semester of their senior year.
 3. The scholarship will be administered by North Wilkes High School's scholarship committee. Selection will be made by the scholarship committee with the senior school counselor of NWHS serving in a non-voting advisory capacity. Final approval will be made by the Board of Directors of Mountain View Medical Center. Applications will be due April 15th of each school year from a student who has applied and been accepted, or expects to be accepted, by an accredited college or university.
 4. The selected recipients must submit a copy of his/her tuition bill to the Mountain View Medical Center Board of Directors at least two weeks prior to the bills due date. A check for the amount of \$1,500.00 will be paid directly to the college or university toward the cost of tuition, room and board, or books and required materials. If a student attends the community college system as a full-time student the maximum payout per semester will be the total cost of tuition, books, and require materials for the college.

Instructions:

1. Applicant must submit completed application and all supporting documents to the NWHS Senior Counselor, by April 15th to be eligible for consideration.
 2. Applicant must include a current photograph with application. This photograph may be used in a press release to local media recognizing the winners.
 3. Applicant must submit copies of acceptance letters, or if no acceptance letters have been received, a brief explanation of their application/admission status.
 4. Applicant must submit a copy of the Student Aid Report from their FAFSA.
 5. A typed one page essay to address the following: Mountain View Medical Center Board of Directors that finishing high school is only the beginning of life long journey. What is your journey?
 5. Applicants are requested to provide (2) sealed letters of reference with applications. (One must be a teacher or administrator at North High, one must be a non-family person from the community, (i.e. minister, scout leader etc.).
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
