



## **NORTH CAROLINA DIVISION OF VETERANS AFFAIRS SCHOLARSHIP**

**IN APPRECIATION FOR THE SERVICE AND SACRIFICES OF NC'S WAR VETERANS, A FOUR YEAR SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM AT NORTH CAROLINA APPROVED SCHOOLS HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR THE QUALIFYING CHILDREN OF CERTAIN CLASS OR CATEGORY OF DECEASED, DISABLED, COMBAT, OR POW/MIA VETERANS.**

### **RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS:**

- APPLICANT MUST BE UNDER AGE 25; A RESIDENT AND DOMICILED IN NC.
- VETERAN PARENT WAS A LEGAL RESIDENT OF NC AT THE TIME OF SAID VETERAN'S ENTRANCE INTO THAT PERIOD OF SERVICE IN THE ARMED FORCES DURING WHICH ELIGIBLY IS ESTABLISHED OR
- THE APPLICANT IS THE NATURAL CHILD/ADOPTED CHILD PRIOR TO AGE 15, WHO WAS BORN IN NC AND HAS BEEN A RESIDENT OF NC CONTINUOUSLY SINCE BIRTH.

### **QUALIFYING CRITERIA FOR VETERAN PARENT:**

**THE VETERANS QUALIFYING CRITERIA MUST HAVE OCCURRED DURING A PERIOD OF WAR.**

1. DIES DURING WARTIME SERVICE OR SERVICE CONNECTED DEATH
2. 100% TOTALLY DISABLED DUE TO WAR TIME DISABILTY
3. 20-90% SERVICE CONNECTED OR RECEIVED PURPLE HEART
4. IN RECEIPT OF NSC PENSION, OR RECEIVED CAMPAIGN MEDAL, OR VETERAN PARENT DECEASED OR
5. FORMER POW/MIA

**FOR CLASS II & III, APLICATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE FEBRUARY 14<sup>TH</sup>.  
CLASSES IA, IB, OR IV MUST BE RECEIVED ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 TO AWARD ON  
JANUARY 1 OR JUNE 1 TO AWARD JULY 1<sup>ST</sup>.**

(FOR CLASS II & III SCHOLARSHIPS, A MIN. CUMULATIVE 2.0 GPA IS REQUIRED).
