PURPOSE: To assist one young man and one young woman in securing formal training beyond high school.

WHO MAY APPLY? Any North Wilkes High School athlete, trainer, manager, or statistician who participated and completed a sports season during their senior year, maintained at least a 3.0 GPA, and has no outstanding debts to the North Wilkes Athletic Department. Each applicant must have the endorsement of the head coach on whose team the applicant participated.

HOW WILL RECIPIENT OF GRANT BE DETERMINED? Each athlete who submits an approved application by the deadline will have the application reviewed by the Viking Athletic Club. One female applicant and one male applicant will be chosen from the applications.

WHO WILL SELECT THE APPLICANTS TO RECEIVE THE GRANTS? Officers of the North Wilkes Vikings Athletic Club, Athletic Director, and School Principal will review the applications and choose the recipients. If an officer has a child/grandchild applying for this grant, that officer will not participate in scholarship selection. Envelopes of the recipients will remain sealed until the Athletic Awards Program.
