The purpose of this scholarship is to assist a former Red Hot Dragon student from Mountain View Elementary who is now a graduating senior from North Wilkes High School in pursuing their college or career challenges by providing a scholarship opportunity. This scholarship may be used for purchasing a required tool or uniform for the work force of their choice or in pursuing to further education at an accredited college or university or work training program. The 5th grade Beta Club will assist in choosing the recipient of this scholarship.

Criteria:

- Individual must be a graduating senior from North Wilkes High School.
- Individual must have attended Mountain View Elementary School for at least one of their elementary school years.
- Individual must be entering or continuing an accredited college/university education or must be entering the work force or a work training program.

Scholarship Amount:

- Scholarship will be in the amount of \$500.

Required Documentation:

- Completed application
- Copy of most recent school transcript
- Proof of admission to an accredited college or university
- Proof of required tools or specialized equipment or uniform for work force.
- Proof of entering work force or work training program
- Essay describing your most inspiring memory of being a Red Hot Dragon at Mtn. View Elementary School (no more than 250 words)
- A letter of recommendation or the attached statement completed (can be from a peer)
